## **The Robin Wyss Scholarship for Officials**

This Scholarship is given to a graduating official that exemplifies dedication and support for the Semiahmoo Minor Hockey officiating program, BC Hockey and Hockey Canada Rules and Regulations. He or she also contributes to hockey beyond the on-ice requirements and combines leadership and ability both on and off the ice. The successful applicant will receive \$1000 that will be paid directly to your post secondary school.

- An active and certified member of the Officials team who has committed to a total of three years of officiating which can include their graduating year.
- Through their actions on and off the ice demonstrates behaviour that receives respect from players/coaches/fellow officials, scorekeepers and timekeepers.
- Does not engage in any behaviour that would portray our association in a negative light
- Has a solid foundation of the rules and regulations of the BC Hockey and Hockey Canada officiating program
- Is a strong leader demonstrated through the Semiahmoo Officials Mentorship program
- Is a strong member and advocate of the Semiahmoo Hockey Program
- If you are a player as well, you will only be required to submit one (1) application to be considered for the Semiahmoo Ravens Hockey Scholarship and the Jack Waterfield Memorial Scholarship
